The 36<sup>th</sup> International Congress on Electrocardiology 2009, following the previous meetings held under auspices of the International Society of Electrocardiology, will cover a broad range of electrocardiology issues, from basic cell processes, like ion channel kinetics, to clinical applications of the numerous fascinating faces of modern electrocardiolgy. Moreover, we will not also forget about prevention of cardiovascular disease and cardiac rehabilitation so that the entire spectrum of "heart problems" could be successfully discussed.

Scientific program of the ICE 2009 will be realized at keynote lectures, oral and poster sessions and special interest satellite symposia with a participation of many distinguished invited speakers.
